Create your own perfume (A1)



Target group	Age: 4-6
Material	 Little jars (as many as possible) Water Plastic sheet Labels + pencils
<u>Procedure</u>	 Start = storytelling about the place where you are with the children to create perfumes (magic, fairy tales, elves,). Every child gets one jar with water in it. They have to collect things (flowers, branches, leaves, pine cones,) from the place around them in order to make a perfume. They can search where ever they want but may not go too far away from their group. First they have to smell every piece they have collected separately. They recognize what is different and decide what they prefer. Then they choose some elements and put them



	together in their jar with the water to create their personal perfume. - They receive one label (and a pencil) for their perfume. They can draw or write (+ their name, the creator's name)
<u>Variations</u>	 You can create perfumes with colours (green, yellow, red,). Collecting things for 1 perfume all together.
<u>Aims</u>	 They have to use their senses (the smelling is the important sense). To develop one's olfactive memories. To learn to compare: for example: find out differences and similarities.
