Target group	Age: 5-6
<u>Material</u>	- Branches from the wood
<u>Procedure</u>	 The children collect branches (one child = 2 branches) Make groups (5 children in one group) The teacher puts the branches in horizontal order on a way. For every group there must be one way and the same number of branches. The children stay in a line. When the teacher counts 1,2,3, one child for every group starts to jump between the branches. When the 1 child has finished the second starts to jump, The winner is the group who finishes jumping first.
<u>Variations</u>	Jumping on one leg.Jumping in pairs.

<u>Aims</u>	 It's a physical activity To feel a member of a team The children have to jump over the branches, be precise in their movements The children have to be fast.
