

Find the treasure (A2)



« treasure »

<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	Forest objects are « treasures » such as leaves, sticks, rocks, etc.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The teacher delimits one space. Then she shows an object that she has chosen.- The teacher explains the activity to the children.- They close their eyes and she hides the object.- All the children search the « treasure » and when one child finds it, he wins the game.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- You can have two groups of children and two places

	<p>delimited. One of them hides the « treasure » in their camp and the other group does the same. At the end they need to find the other group's object.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Instead of forest objects, the teacher can use a prize that she had made or bought.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn to identify elements from the environment and touch them. - Develop the observation and the comparison between similar objects. - Learn to situate in a specific space.
