

Parachute: Sing a song (A2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	Parachute
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- All the children need to form a circle while they catch the parachute.- When the circle is formed they need to walk two steps to the middle of the circle.- When the parachute is full of air the children sit down in the parachute formed a kind of igloo.- With all the children sitting on the ground, they sing

	<p>songs in different languages and they do the choreography of the song.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If the parachute falls down, they need to do repeat all the movement again.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - While the group of children is singing a song, one or two children can dance in the middle of the circle and under the parachute.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Develop the auditory skill. - Find out differences and similarities between the different languages. - Learn to compare and discover the songs with different rhythms and repetitions. - Develop listening to and playing with other sounds and words in other languages.
