Parachute - change the colour (A2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	Parachute
<u>Procedure</u>	 All the children form a circle, they hold one part / one colour of the parachute. When the circle is formed the children or a teacher can say that two colours have to change places. E.g. Blue and red. The children who were holding a blue or a red part of the parachute go under the parachute and change places.



<u>Variations</u>	 After having used only two colours, they can use four colours to do the changes.
<u>Aims</u>	 Learn to identify and distinguish the different colours. Develop one's visual and auditory skills. Learn to observe, compare and discover the colours with different rhythms and repetitions.
