<u>Material</u>	 Plate from nature Signs to find the way to the elf Soccer field CDs to look through Branches Tape

<u>Procedure</u>	 We go the class and we sing the song with the children the song of our names. We make CDs to look in the class We go to the park and we follow the signs Stops on the way: Give children their wings and their special glasses (CDs) Soccer fields (let children discover it) At the lake - do a special elves dance (duck dance or the children can invent something)



	 Pick up treasures on the way to give to the elf. Put their things together in the first elf place. Find the elf. The elf leads the children to the cave and they lay the treasures for the elf. The elf starts to tell stories. The children also sing (name song). Children come out and the adults ask children how it smelled inside and what the elf said. The children can make the perfume. When we get out of the forest, we need to hide a few times and we can play hide and seek or ask the children for any ideas.
<u>Variations</u>	 Children make soccer field or another field for the elves to play.
<u>Aims</u>	The children work on the vocabulary (mother tongue) because they tell the story of the elf. The children learn to distinguish different smells. The children dare use their body in the nature. They climb, go under something, The children create a composition for giving to the elves.
