Create insects (B1)



Target group	Age : 4-6 1 adult : 5-10
Material	 Glue Paper Magnifying glass - box Natural material (Frames)
Procedure	 Start with the activity "Treasure hunting" → The kids collect some natural material The teacher proposes to the kids to look for some insects and then to look at them in details with the magnifying glass / box. Speak about what they see, describe what they see (point out the different characteristics about the insects, the similarities, differences like paws, antenna, colours) Go back in class and give them all the natural material they have collected (see "Treasure hunting). The teacher invites the kids to invent/create a new insect

	 (imaginary one) based on the characteristics that have been discovered just before. Than the kids make a collage with glue on a paper and they can make an exhibition of their collages in the classroom. And why not propose to the kids to give a name to their insect.
<u>Variations</u>	 After the collage you can use / create a frame to put it in evidence
<u>Aims</u>	 Observe details and see similarities and differences Dare take insects Use creativity and imagination Oriented on the paper (mathematics)→ establish connections between objects found in the nature to make an insect
