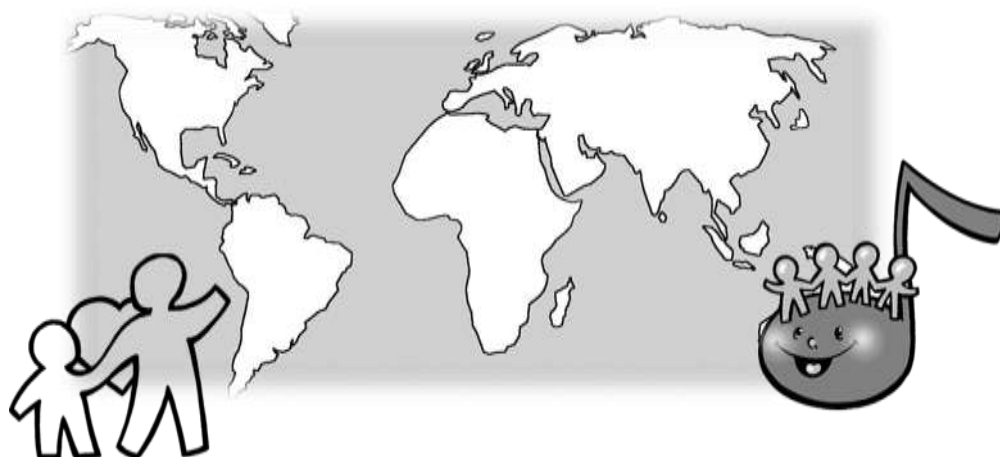


Getting to know each other (B2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- A map and stickers- A ball of wool- Natural materials to make instruments (stones, wood sticks, leaves, etc.)- Music- Fluffy kangaroo
<u>Procedure</u>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The children say 'hello' to us in different languages (learned with their teacher)2. We sing one song to say 'hello' in our languages3. We introduce ourselves and show the pictures of the country where we come from. We ask the children to show us on the map where we should stick the pictures.4. Game with the names: we sit in a circle. The teacher throws a ball of wool to a child and says his name at

	<p>the same time. The teacher holds the starting point of the wool. Then the child has to do the same and to continue until having a spider web and everybody has said his name.</p> <p>5. Music activity with natural instruments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Play with all the materials while the music is on and when we stop the music be silent. - Choose a material and play with it when it's the musical part and walk around when there is the lyrics. If they know the song they can sing it. - Jump as a kangaroo during the instrumental part and swing during the lyrics. - Sit in a circle and pass the fluffy kangaroo to each other during the song.
