
## Getting to know each other (B2)



Target group	Age: 4-6
Material	<ul> <li>A map and stickers</li> <li>A ball of wall</li> <li>Natural materials to make instruments (stones, wood sticks, leaves, etc.)</li> <li>Music</li> <li>Fluffy kangaroo</li> </ul>
<u>Procedure</u>	<ol> <li>The children say 'hello' to us in different languages (learned with their teacher)</li> <li>We sing one song to say 'hello' in our languages</li> <li>We introduce ourselves and show the pictures of the country where we come from. We ask the children to show us on the map where we should stick the pictures.</li> <li>Game with the names: we sit in a circle. The teacher throws a ball of wool to a child and says his name at</li> </ol>

	<ul> <li>the same time. The teacher holds the starting point of the wool. Then the child has to do the same and to continue until having a spider web and everybody has said his name.</li> <li>5. Music activity with natural instruments <ul> <li>Play with all the materials while the music is on and when we stop the music be silent.</li> <li>Choose a material and play with it when it's the musical part and walk around when there is the lyrics. If they know the song they can sing it.</li> <li>Jump as a kangaroo during the instrumental part and swing during the lyrics.</li> <li>Sit in a circle and pass the fluffy kangoroo to each other during the song.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
