<p><u>Target group</u></p>	<p>Age : 6</p>
<p><u>Material</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jars - Tape (to stick) - Plastic cups - Coloured pipe cleaners - Branches - Cds 
<p><u>Procedure</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discover the materials that the teacher has brought: glasses made of two plastic cups, CD using the hole in the middle to make a microscope, jars, ... - Within a small defined area, find some little secrets which could be important for the children and use the material to have them look at your little secrets. - If you find something interesting put it into the jar and share your treasure with the group.

<u>Variations</u>	- make 3 groups in 3 different areas so that they can find different secrets
<u>Aims</u>	Learn to look at things from another perspective Learn to observe in details Use the creativity of the children
