



<u>Target group</u>	Age: 4-6
<u>Material</u>	
<u>Procedure</u>	 Children are in the forest. They sit in a circle. They have to listen the different sounds of nature. Then they have to repeat what they heard. If the sound was close they have to repeat it loud, and if the sound was further they have to repeat it quietly.
<u>Variations</u>	 They can draw what they hear on a CD made of paper. The teacher can record the sounds and children have to guess what they hear.
Aims	 Observe the environment. Distinguish sounds and identify them. Try to be silent.

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
