

Landscape observation (C1)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 3-6
<u>Material</u>	Landscape
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The teacher makes two groups.- Each group has to choose and observe one part of the landscape.- They have to represent it with their bodies, like a picture (for example: a river, a tree and a bird) The other group has to guess what they are representing. Then they have to change. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The teacher puts music and when it stops children have to represent what they did before.
