

# Find the same material (C2)



<u>Target group</u>	4-5 years
<u>Material</u>	All kinds of material from the nature: branches, stones, leaves,... Scarves
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- All the children receive one element of the nature. They can experiment with it making noise.</li><li>- All children are blindfolded.</li><li>- There are at least two items of the same material. So there will be always at least two children who get the same material.</li><li>- The children have to make a sound with the material they have received.</li><li>- Then they have to listen and find someone who is making a sound with the same material.</li><li>- Then they try to go in the direction of the sound that is the same as theirs and touch the child who is doing</li></ul>

	the same kind of sound.
<u>Variations</u>	- You can make it easier by making bigger groups. So there are more of the same materials.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Learn to compare</li> <li>- Act and produce using the element of nature</li> <li>- To discover different ways of producing sounds</li> <li>- To discover rhythm, pace and beat</li> <li>- Use their senses (ear)</li> <li>- Compositions: layout with different rhythms, repetitions, changes.</li> </ul>
