

Searching for colours (C2)



<u>Target group</u>	3-4-5 years
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Colour guide (paintings) - Time switch - An outdoor place
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - On colour guide per 1 or 2 children - The children choose one colour on the colour guide. - A child turns the time switch - They have a limited area to search as many things as possible with the same colour as the one they have chosen in the colour guide. - When the time switch rings the game stops - The children show each other what they have found and discuss the colour (Does it match or not?). "I found this leaf on the floor and it can be in two colours dark brown and light brown, and then I found another leaf but on a tree and it's a green one and not a brown one."

<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Number of colours depends on the age (1 or two colours for 3 years old,...) - We can do this inside, in a classroom or in the playground.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observe, compare and discover colours, materials. - Develop vocabulary to express what you feel - Develop vocabulary connected the different senses.
<u>Comments</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For the time, children have to choose before the 1st and 2nd line (0 to 5' and 5' to 10') - Tell them not go too far away, stay within fixed limits

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
